


Service Project Ideas

- **Soup Kitchen**
Hunger and poverty remains a critical issue. Find an organization that serves meals to the needy and dedicate an evening of your time feeding and preparing food for the homeless.
- **Supply/Canned Food Drive**
Help the less fortunate by organizing a school-wide or community-wide drive for basic necessities or canned goods.
- **Tutoring**
Support the major emphasis and tutor struggling students in school. Contact elementary schools, middle schools, your own high school, or the public library to either participate in or even launch a tutoring program.
- **Book Buddies**
Reading is an important literary skill. Team up with the public library and schedule a time to read to young children.
- **Appreciation cards**
Whether its Christmas, Valentine's Day or not a holiday at all, honor those important to you with warm greeting cards! Thank your teachers and troops or wish families and the sick a pleasant holiday.
- **Nursing Home volunteer**
